

Update on Conversion of Transitional Grandfathered Rights at Chateauguay

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Conversion Election Results

- ◆ Per Section 5.12.2.C of the Market Services Tariff, the NYISO accepted requests to convert Transitional Grandfathered Rights at the Chateauguay interface received by February 1.
- ◆ The resulting External CRIS Rights awards were computed according to the process defined in Section 5.12.2.C of the Market Services Tariff.
- ◆ The awarded External CRIS Rights will be first effective for the Winter 2010-2011 Capability Period.
