On May 25, 2007, you filed on behalf of ISO New England Inc. (ISO-NE) revised tariff sheets extending the deadline for composite offers in the first Forward Capacity Auction from June 15, 2007 to July 2, 2007. Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Tariffs and Market Development-East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, your submittal filed in the above referenced docket is accepted for filing, effective June 14, 2007, as requested.

Notice of the filing was published in the Federal Register with comments, protests or interventions due on or before June 1, 2007.<sup>1</sup> No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of interventions and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214). Any unopposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification or any rule, regulation or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your filing; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have
