Dear Messrs. May and Belval:

On December 10, 2009, you submitted on behalf of ISO New England Inc. (ISO) and the New England Power Pool Participants Committee (NEPOOL) a filing in response to a November 10, 2009 letter order in Docket No. ER10-62-000<sup>1</sup> (November 10 Order). The November 10 Order conditionally accepted your proposed methodology for calculating the Financial Assurance Requirement for a Market Participant shedding a Capacity Supply Obligation in the Forward Capacity Market subject to the methodology

being included into the ISO Tariff. The current filing complies with this requirement by adding language to the ISO Tariff describing the methodology.<sup>2</sup> The proposed tariff revisions are accepted effective November 13, 2009 as requested.

Public notice of the filing was published in the Federal Register with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before December 31, 2009. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2009)).

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification or any rule, regulation or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your filing; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or any which may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against the ISO.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713 (2009).
